Some recent facts covered in a report by Centre for human Ecology, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Deonar, India (2014) on children and mental well-being have quoted as follows: i. 1 in every 10 school-going children have some form of learning disability estimate studies. ii. 14% of global disease burden attributed to neuropsychiatric disorders (including autism, Down's syndrome, attention deficit hyperactive disorder) in children. iii. 10%- of 5-15 year olds in India have a diagnosable mental health disorder; around 90% of them do not receive any specialized services says a UNESCO report (2008) iv. About 39% kids below 5 not reaching developmental potential because of poverty, malnutrition, high rates of infection, lack of education and instability in the home in developing nations.
